7. Plan Upsells

- Ads management or consulting as add-ons.
- Extra Al flows: reviews, upsells, memberships.

Offer upgrades after the first visible win so they feel like a natural next step.

▲ Common Pitfalls

- Too many niches at once: focus first, expand later.
- · Feature overload: outcomes sell, not long menus.
- Skipping support: onboarding decides retention.
- Pricing paralysis: pick one, adjust later.
- · Doing everything alone forever: hire a VA for repeat tasks.
